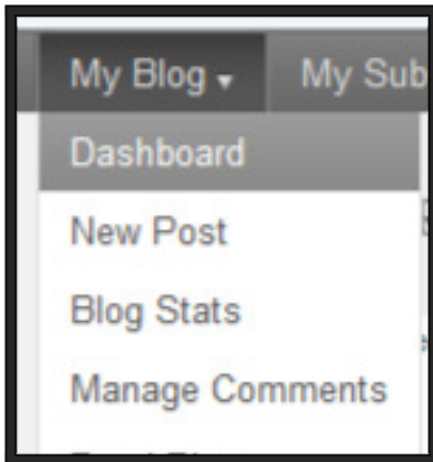


Publishing a post



Go to www.wordpress.com and sign in. Once you've signed in, under "My Blog" in the top left of the screen, choose "Dashboard". (If you're registered to more than one blog, you'll need to choose "My Blogs", select the blog to which you wish to contribute and then select "Dashboard".

The "QuickPress" box is on the right hand side of the screen. From here you can create a post. Remember your title, and type the content of the post into "Content" - and that's it! Press "Publish" and your post is public.
